IMPORTANT NOTES & FACULTY SENATE EXAM POLICY

HOW TO READ THE FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE

The far-left column contains FINAL EXAM DATES (days when exams are offered).

In the second column, locate the first day of the week that your course section is held.

In the third column, locate the start time of said course section.

The correlating cell in the fourth column will provide the start/end time of your exam.

NYS CONTACT HOUR REQUIREMENTS

Regular semester courses are scheduled in accordance with New York State's minimum contact hour requirement. Both regular class days and final exam offerings are included in meeting the minimum requirement. As is such – All regular semester courses are to run full term and not cancelled. Likewise – Final Exams or their equivalent (i.e. final paper, project, presentation, etc.) must be offered during the designated Final Exam Week (Final Exams are NOT to be offered during the last week of regular classes).

FACULTY SENATE POLICIES GOVERNING FINAL EXAMS

If an instructor requires a final examination, he or she may not administer the exam during the final two weeks of classes.

During the final two weeks of class, an instructor may administer an in-class examination that does not count as any part of the final exam – only if he or she administers a final exam during the designated time period (Final Exam Week).

To minimize distractions during written exams, students should plan to remain in the examination room for at least one hour.
