Admission Requirements and Prerequisite Coursework (as of April 2025)

The Master of Science in Clinical Mental Health Counseling is a 60-credit curriculum that is designed to lead to eligibility to apply for a limited permit and provide preparation for the National Clinical Mental Health Counseling Exam and eventual full licensure as a mental health counselor in New York state.

Admission Requirements for the MS Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program:

1. Completed online application. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Students begin the graduate program in the fall semester.
A link to the online application and respective deadlines is available at www.lemoyne.edu/graduateadmission.
2. Official transcripts showing a completed bachelor's degree with an appropriate major (or, one scheduled to be completed by the time the program begins).
Although any major is welcome, we see most applicants from majors in human services, psychology, counseling or related fields.
3. Three letters of recommendation (which will be submitted via the online application).
4. Résumé or CV
5. Examples of relevant field experience, such as volunteer, internship or work experience, at a minimum of 20 hours.
6. The application will prompt you to upload an essay addressing professional statement objectives.
